

Submission of Abstracts

One-page abstract should be submitted by July 31, 2008, to either fbg2008@home.ipe.ac.cn or kinyasakanishi@aist.go.jp. After reviewing process by the symposium committee, authors will be notified of acceptance or rejection of their abstracts. Full papers for accepted abstracts are required to be submitted to the above two emails before September 30, 2008.

Publication and Proceedings

A booklet will be edited to collect the abstracts of all accepted contributions, which will be distributed to the registered participants during the symposium. The submitted full papers will be reviewed for special issues in Elsevier Journals. The journals in consideration include *Fuel Processing Technology* and *China Particuology*.
